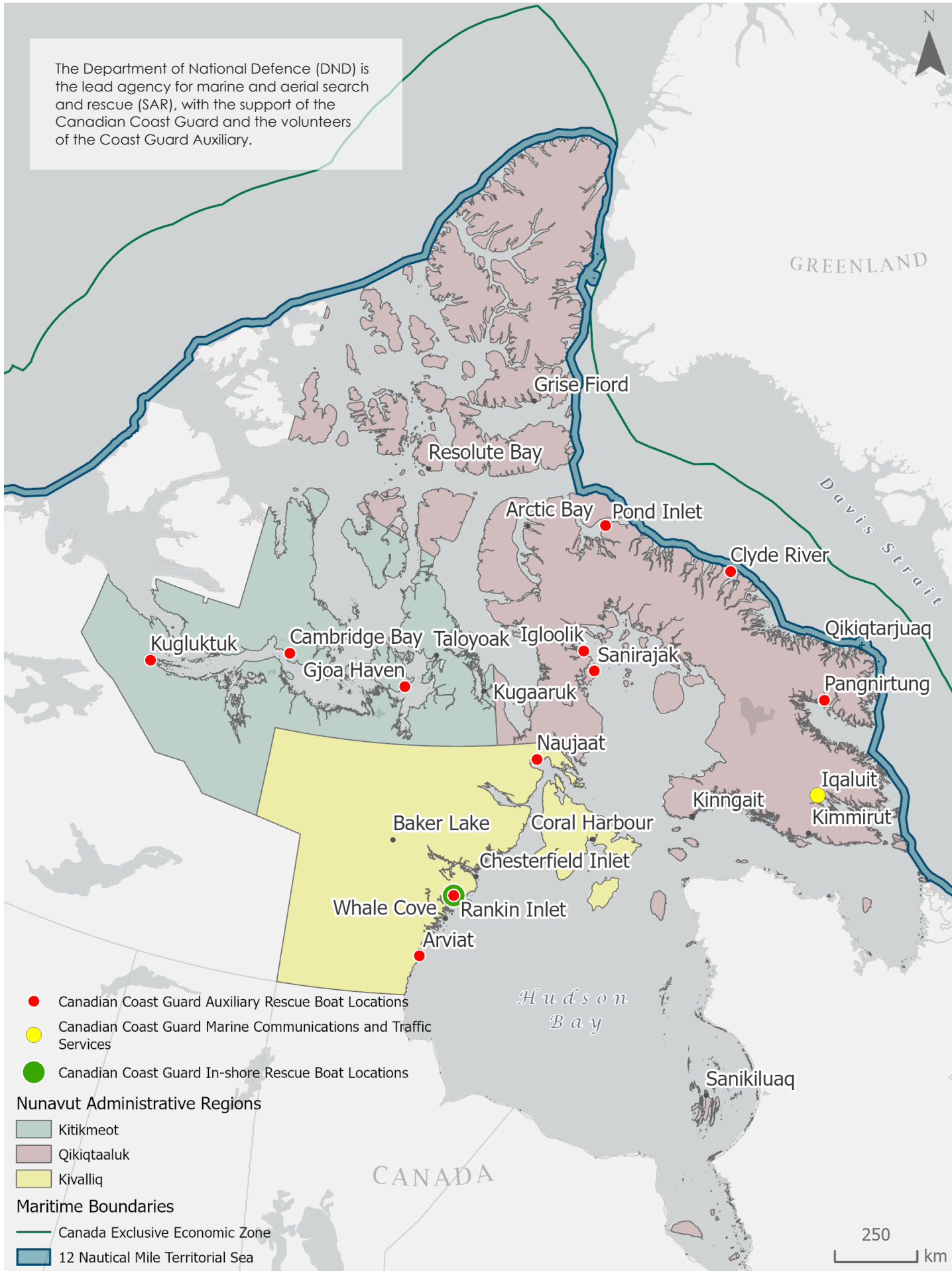

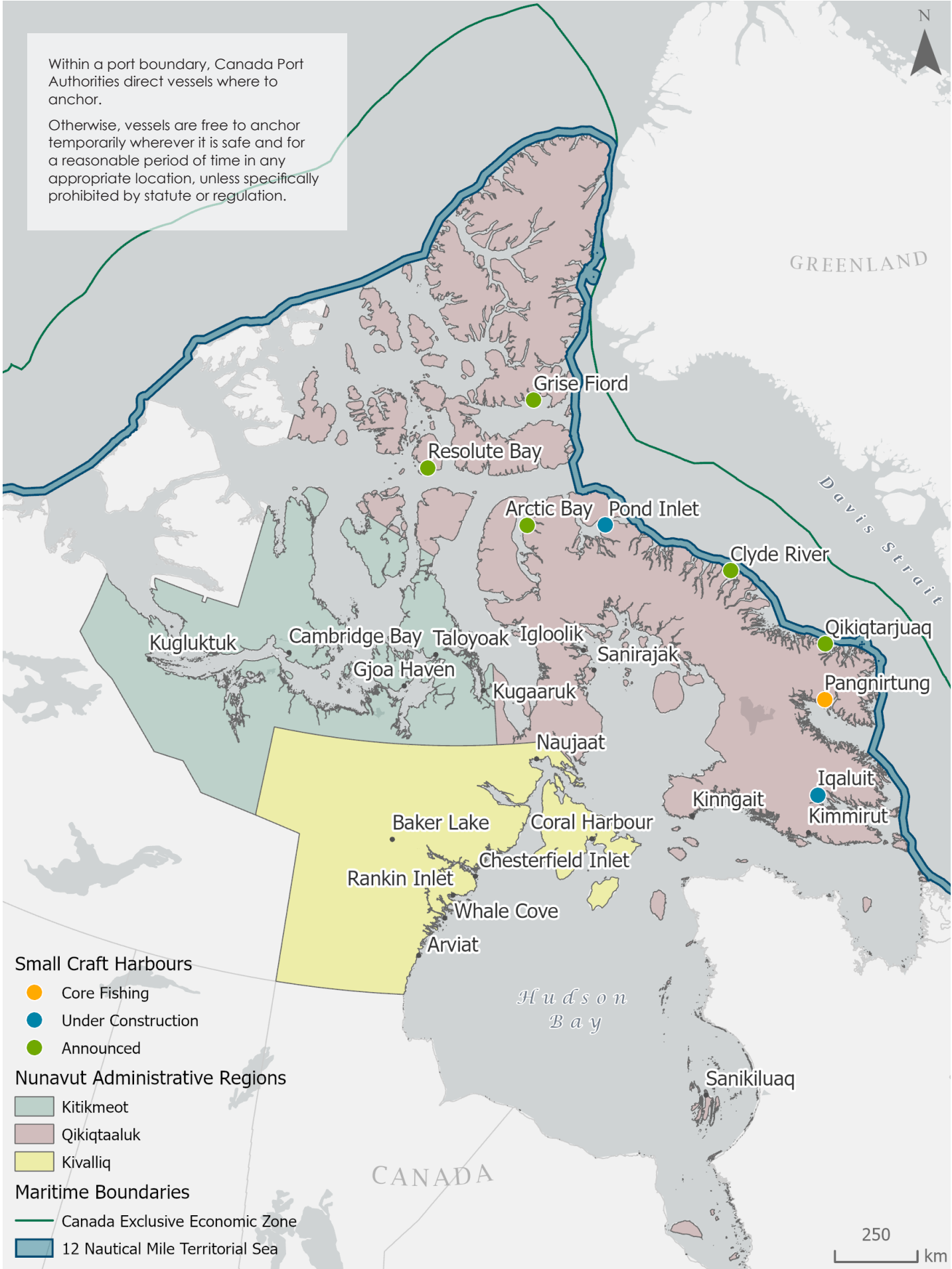
Locations of CCG Auxiliary Coast Guard Units

VESSEL ANCHORAGE

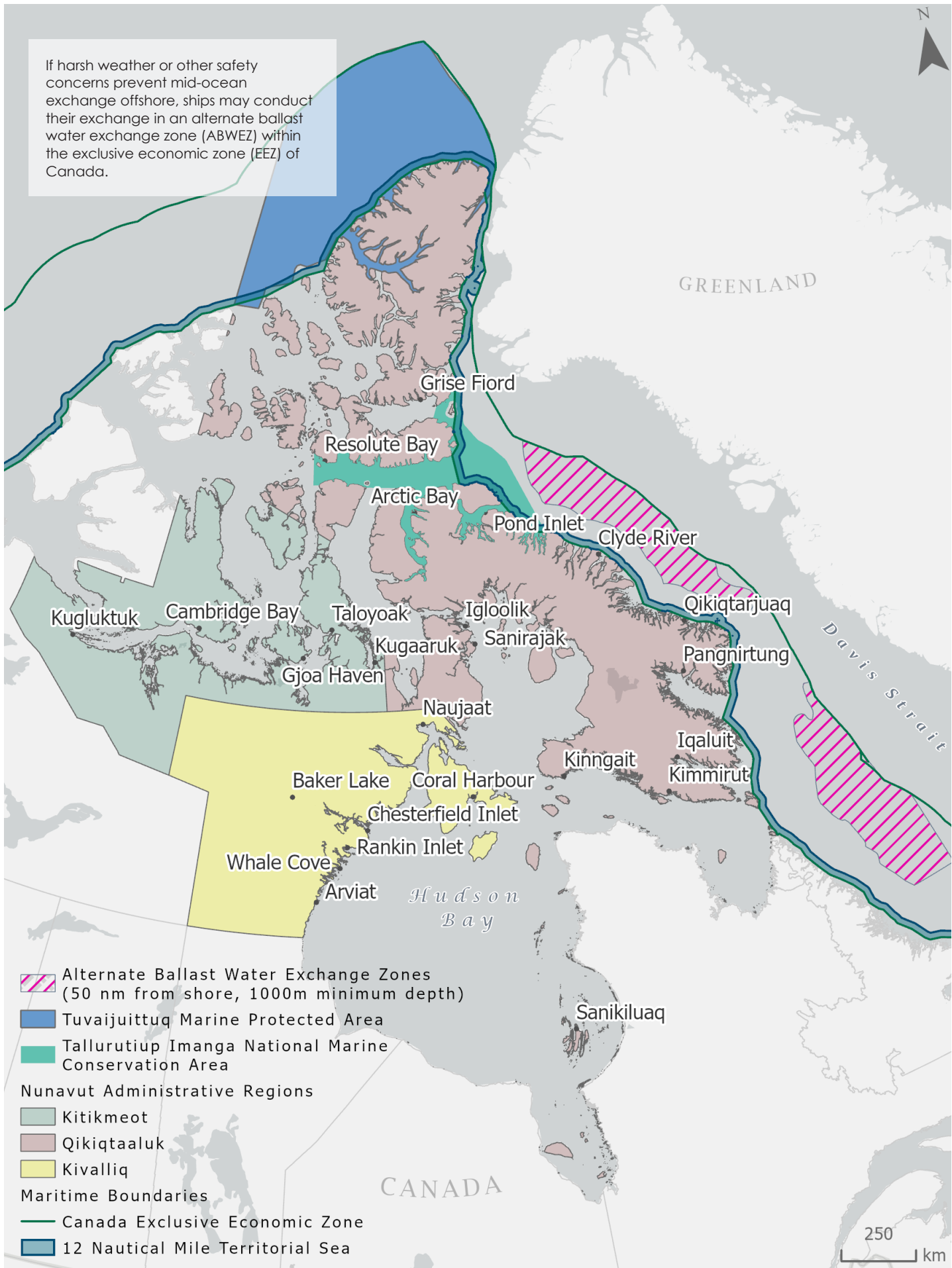
Locations of active or announced small craft harbours and ports

VESSEL DISCHARGES

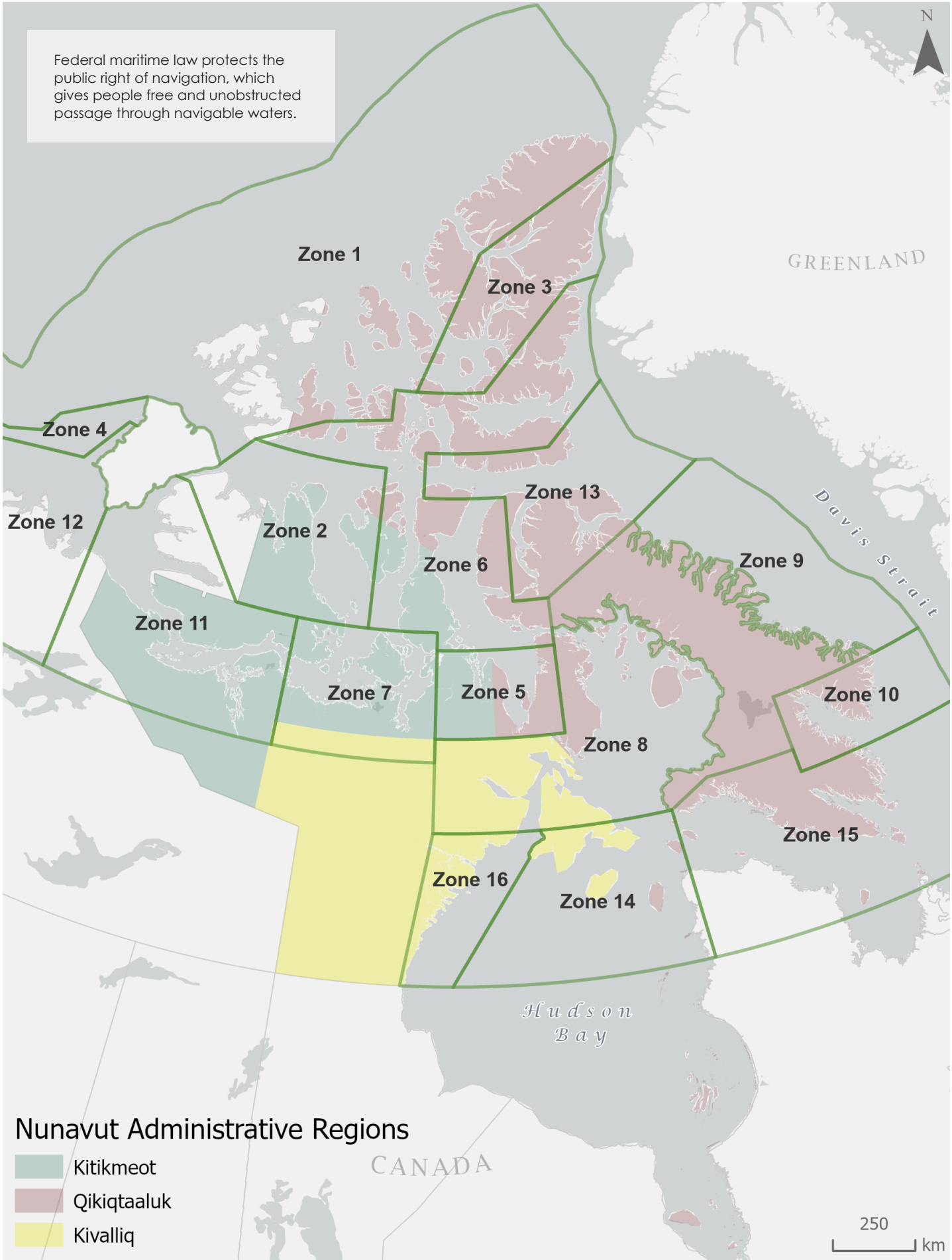
Locations of alternate ballast water exchange zones
